GLORIA:

The Creed

Foundation Governor Recruitment: The Diocese of Northampton is seeking to appoint a foundation Governor for St. Bernard's Catholic Grammar School, Slough.

The suitable candidate must be a practising Catholic over the age of 18 who values the importance of Catholic education in the local community. A background in education is not required, but skills from other professional spheres are greatly welcomed.
