01st April 2025

Depart Luton at 06.30am airport for the flight to Split. On arrival we transfer to Medjugorje where we check-in to the accommodation for 4 nights stay on half board basis.

02nd, 03rd 04th April 2025

Our local guide will accompany you throughout the Pilgrimage and will advise the daily programme. Each evening at dinner the schedule for the following day will be posted in the dining room.

English Mass each morning at 10am at St James Church. At 5pm each evening we will join local villagers and pilgrims to pray the Joyful and Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary and the Blessing of the Sick. On Tuesdays, Thursdays, there is Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. For those that can, we will walk up Apparition Hill on one of the days reciting the Rosary along the way, there will be a visit to Cenacolo.

We depart today and return to Split to join the flight back to Luton which departs at 7.00pm and lands at 8.40pm UK time.
