**General Election 2024:** As you will be aware, the Prime Minister, has called a general election for 4<sup>th</sup> July. This means that parliament has been dissolved and all parliamentary business suspended. The criminal justice bill including the amendments on abortion will not proceed through the commons at this time.
