Jude has very kindly agreed to go and look after Holy Redeemer Parish and as a result, Fr. Jude will not be around for a few weeks.

**Praise & Worship:** Our monthly Praise and Worship which will take place on Friday, 28<sup>th</sup> March at 7pm – 9pm. All are welcome to this very special service.

**Important Car Park Notice:** An important reminder for those of you who drive to church when attending services, please note that cars should **not** be parked on the pavement outside the church. There is ample parking on church grounds in the front and side car park if we all park considerately. On days we have services that are well attended, if the car park is full, please use the multi storey car park in the Queensmere Shopping Centre which is just a few minutes' walk to the church.

In addition, as an additional safety precaution, we ask that anyone who is driving in and out of our car park do this slowly and take care to ensure there are no cyclists or pedestrians crossing the pavement entrances to the church.

**Important Note – Confessions**: Following a Diocesan Formation meeting we have been advised that if mobile phones are left on and are with you during your confession, Google can record parts of it. Therefore, to protect the sanctity of confession we therefore request that going forward <u>all mobile phones</u> are either not taken into the confessional with you or are <u>completely</u> switched off to protect what is said during confession and to avoid breaking the seal.

**Special Mass for Married Couples:** We invite all married couples to a special mass on **Saturday**, **26**<sup>th</sup> **April** at 12pm. **Please note the change of date.** For those of you who are celebrating their **significant** wedding anniversaries e.g. 10, 15, 25, 30 years of marriage this year we will produce a special certificate. If this applies to you, please put your details down on the list at the back of the church. You will be able to receive this during the service on the day.

### Diocesan Pilgrimage to Walsingham

This year our diocesan pilgrimage to Walsingham takes place on Saturday 14 June. The pilgrimage will begin with Mass at the Basilica in the Catholic Shrine at midday followed by lunch and at 3pm pilgrims process from the Shrine, on the holy mile to the Abbey Grounds for the final service. There is a form at the back of the church to sign up if you are interested. If there are sufficient numbers, we will look into booking a coach. Parish groups are welcome to attend and encouraged to bring parish banners with them for the procession. All are welcome.
